

Arriving on Campus and Parking

The Newnham campus is located at 1750 Finch Avenue East, just west of the Don Valley Parkway and east of Don Mills Road. Enter Building A+ as that is the main designated entrance. If you are driving, we recommend parking in lot 1, 3, or 4 to be closer to the main entrance. Other parking lots are accessible as well but avoid parking in lots 2, 6, 8, and 10.

Dress

Business attire is mandatory for competitors and Advisors. Jackets and blazers are optional.

- Males (dress pants, dress shirt and tie, dress shoes)
- Females (professional shirt/blouse, skirt/dress pants, dress shoes)

Official DECA Dress Code will apply and will be enforced! No school uniforms!

Format

- Competitors will complete one role-play (team event) in front of a judge. Provincial DECA preparation times will be enforced.
- Students should come to Seneca Polytechnic prepared for the day with, for example: lunch money, all DECA materials, books to read, IPod, pencil, calculator, change of shoes (if necessary).

Restrictions

There MUST be teacher supervision. Students are not allowed to compete without an advisor on Seneca property

Behavior for Delegates

Registration

There will be NO official registration other than for advisors/judges. There will be Seneca Student Ambassadors wearing "red t-shirts" stationed throughout the college where information and/or assistance can be obtained. All students need to do is ensure that you arrive **15 MINUTES** prior to your scheduled testing and oral time slots.

As you are dropped off at Seneca, organize yourself by finding your prep and judge rooms. Pay close attention to the rooms indicated on your timetables; the letter indicates the building, and the number indicates the room within that building. Please use the attached map to help orient yourself.

Please note that there WILL NOT be an area where personal items can be left unattended. Participants are expected to bring all of their belongings with them to each event so pack smart and ensure that you do not bring anything of high value and/or importance.
