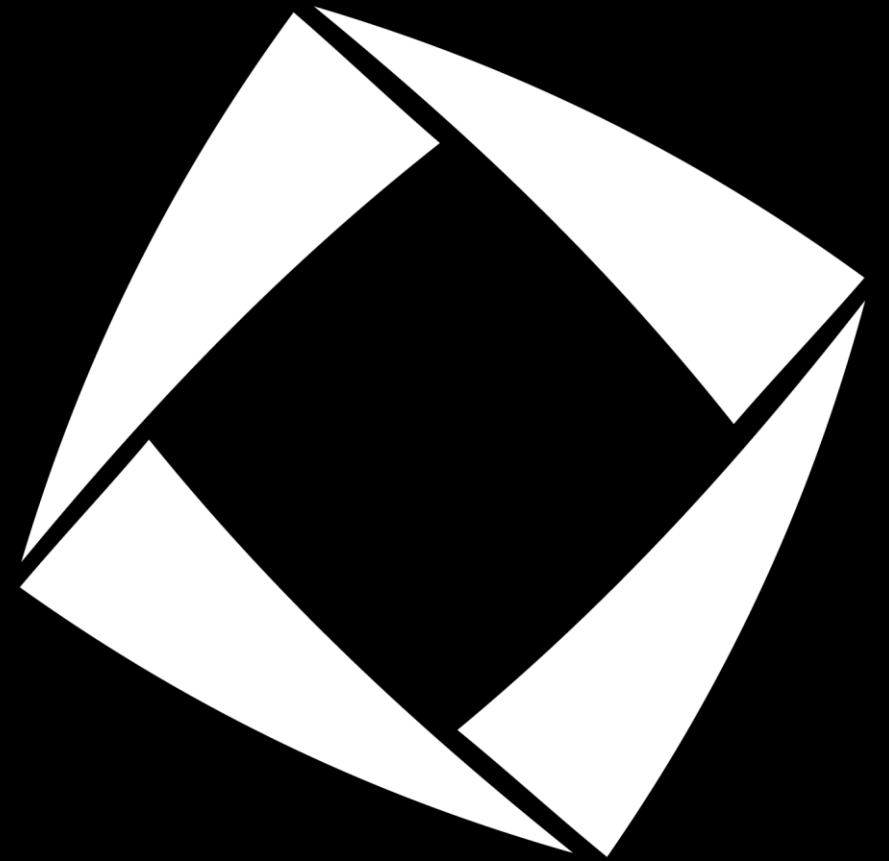

CUSTOMS

- Passport and appropriate documentation
- Cross in groupings of 10 or less
- Paperwork SIGNED and complete
- **Photocopy passports as a backup** in case they are lost or stolen
- Canadian Embassy in LA
- Keep the ORANGE cover page with you when you cross – address will be required at check-in
- Baggage fees will apply and will differ per airline; credit /debit card
- Online check-in for all except United Airlines

THINGS TO DO BEFORE YOU GET TO ANAHEIM

- Students need to be read the 'riot' act by you; may be sent back home for inappropriate behaviour
- Pack smart; maximum of one large luggage per person allowance (luggage fees) and a backpack/purse
- Find out from your Board if swimming is allowed; get permission forms signed; cannot simply turn a blind eye
- Set up telephone tree, especially for large chapters, for parents when calls need to be made in Canada (i.e. LA riots one year, plane delays)

- If you are **supervising students from within your Board**, call them and introduce yourself; they are **100%** your responsibility; please make sure they are welcome into your fold
