



Payment and Cancellation Policy

Payment

Students pay for their membership dues directly through the online portal registration system. They can register and pay any time up to October 1. Payment is made online using a credit card.

Membership Fees

Combined Student Membership/Regionals fee: **\$35 PER PERSON PLUS \$2 SERVICE FEE***

(ALL questions must be completed and a valid email address must be used).

Breakdown of Membership Dues/Regionals fee (HST is NOT applicable):

\$14	DECA Inc Membership dues
\$8	DECA Ontario Membership dues**
\$13	Regionals fee (online testing + regional competition)

- NO cancellations, NO refunds, NO changes to membership after October 1
- Used to pay DECA Inc Membership dues for Advisors, Partners and Alumni **

Refund Policy

Our refund policy is as follows:

- Refunds will be provided through our online payment system; STRIPE.
- Once the online registration portal closes on October 1, midnight, no refunds will be allowed after this deadline.

Provincials Fees

Chapters are strictly prohibited from booking accommodation outside the DECA block. All hotel reservations must go through the DECA Ontario.

DAY REGISTRANTS: \$60 - \$120 per person (HST included)

OVERNIGHT REGISTRANTS (ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS):

Overnight registrant fees vary based on [hotel](#) choice. Options are:

- Toronto Sheraton

Entire chapter must stay at the same hotel; based on first-come-first-served basis. Provincials portal opens November 27.

Cancellation Policy

Membership Fees

Your registration is not finalized, even if payment is received. Your Chapter Advisor must approve your application. Each school has various levels of commitment, student expectations, chapter size limits, etc. Failing to meet these requirements will mean that your application will not be honoured by DECA Ontario.

If that is the case, and a payment was made, a full refund will be issued to the credit card holder.

NO cancellations, NO refunds, NO changes to membership after October 15.

Provincials Fees

Payment for the Provincial Competition must be received within 10 days of the registration deadline (therefore payment must be RECEIVED by December 14th, 2020). Chapters with outstanding balances thereafter will not be scheduled for the Provincial Competition.

Cancellations?

Prior to December 30: Provincial Competition fee per participant are non-refundable

December 31 to January 20: If schools are staying overnight, the accommodation portion may be refunded, if and only if, a room can be collapsed.

January 21 to February 7: No changes; no housing refunds will be allowed

ICDC Fees

Payment for the ICDC Competition must be received within 10 days of the registration deadline (therefore payment must be RECEIVED by March 1, 2021).

Cancellations?

Cancellations between February 9 – March 1 \$100 administration fee for cancelling is made payable to DECA Ontario; DECA Ontario will then look at finding a replacement for the student/teams that withdrew and will go down the top 10 Provincials Qualifiers list until a suitable replacement is found

Cancellations between March 1 – April 24 Cancellations will now have to go through insurance and only if the reasons are deemed insurable. Please see policy for full details:
